Mr Chee Yoh Chuang (Covering New Lakeside)

Yoh Chuang is a senior partner of RSM Chio Lim LLP and Executive Director of Stone Forest Corporate Advisory Pte Ltd. He has almost 30 years of experience in insolvency and restructuring, acting as Judicial Manager, Scheme Manager, Receiver, Liquidator and Financial Advisor in corporate restructuring. He is actively involved in investigation assignments, including conducting special audit on companies listed on the Stock Exchange of Singapore. Yoh Chuang is a member of the Board of Directors, Insolvency Practitioners Association of Singapore. He was a member of the Insolvency Law Review Committee and received the "Minister for Law Outstanding Volunteer Award" in 2012.

Mr Nish Shetty (Covering Drydocks World)

Nish leads the Litigation and Dispute Resolution (South- east Asia) practice at Clifford Chance. He is also a highly regarded restructuring lawyer in Singapore and has worked on most of the largest and most high profile insolvency cases in Singapore in the last 20 years, including Barings, Asia Pulp & Paper, Econ Corp, Drydocks World and TT International. These cases represent in many instances the locus classicus for many aspects of insolvency law in Singapore. Nish is a member of the Board of Directors of the Insolvency Practitioners Association of Singapore (IPAS) and was the Vice-Chairman of the Law Society's Insolvency Practice Committee.
